

Student Voice

- Students participate actively at least 50% of instructional time.
- Students are facile with and use the language of the content area in responses.
- Students respond in complete sentences.
- Given some basic general information students are able to work their way through difficult content with peers.
- Students are encouraged to ask many questions to ensure their understanding of content and process.

• Students:

- Are able to explain complex concepts
- o Are able to provide analogous situations to the example (s) used in class.
- Participate in classroom discussions by adding to previous comments, disagreeing to previous comments and taking the discussion in a new direction to expand understanding of concepts.
- Give thorough explanations of their understanding of complex content and/or processes
- Analyze their errors and/or misconceptions to reach a true understanding of complex content
- Assignments include some student choice.
