

## When there are two teachers in the room...

- The classroom teacher begins the lesson on time
- The push-in or co- teacher arrives promptly to the classroom
- Lesson is planned and choreographed by both teachers
- Both teachers have strong knowledge of the curriculum standards and materials
- Each teacher both presents and assists during instruction
- Both teachers assist all students during the lesson
- Teachers collaborate on assessment to determine student understanding and next steps for instruction
- Co Planning time is <u>essential</u> for any model of push in or co- teaching to be successful
- Remember:
  - The push-in or co-teacher is NOT an extra pair of hands in the lesson
  - The push-in or co-teacher does not consistently service one particular group of students over time
